



DRESS CODE PEPSI USBC YOUTH REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT

Tournament bowlers must abide by the following dress code rules during all competition. The competition's director and other event officials will be enforcing the dress code rules. If you think your apparel is questionable, refer it to the competition's director for approval **BEFORE** it is worn. In case the apparel is not approved, bring alternate clothes that unquestionably follow the dress code. Failure to comply with any dress code rule will result in a verbal warning and apparel change {if applicable}. Second offense will result in a verbal warning, apparel change {if applicable}, and/or possible disqualification for that block and following blocks until rectified.

- A. The "Official" USBC shirt is recommended, but not mandatory.
- B. All apparel worn by bowlers must be **loose fitting** and respectable. Torn, holes or extremely baggy clothes will not be allowed. Bowlers will not be allowed to write on or deface their bowling shirts at any time. Hats **cannot be worn** during practice or competition.
- C. All bowlers will be required to wear full length slacks/jeans in black, tan or denim during practice and competition. Again, no baggy or torn jeans will be allowed.
- D. Neat appearance in clothing and personal grooming is required by all competitors. Pictures of winners will be taken and published in local newspapers, BCAW newsletter and other types of publications. This dress code is required as you are representatives of our sport.
- E. Any protest of Rules A-D must be taken care of/addressed before start of competition.
- F. No smoking, alcohol, chewing or foul language will be permitted in the bowling area.

No headphone, cell phones, or I-Pods will be allowed.
